Paskov Multimodal Container Terminal

2015-CZ-TM-0330-M

Baltic-Adriatic Corridor



The core freight terminal of Paskov is located 13 km south of Ostrava on the Baltic -Adriatic Corridor. The aim of the Action is to improve the efficiency of the terminal by reducing loading/unloading operations and to allow the accommodation of 740 meters long trains. The Action is the third and final phase of a global project consisting in the modernisation and upgrading of this terminal and is divided in 2 main components: 1) Works for extension of railway tracks (2 new tracks of 365 m length). 2) Study and works for the reconstruction of railway siding station (3 new tracks of 750 m length). Overall, the Action will contribute to increased co-modality in the Moravian-Silesian region.

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
